Priority Program Deadline: February 1

- ❑ **Transcripts** — In addition to your preliminary transcript, a final, official transcript is required to complete your admissions file. Applicants who transfer in more than 60 credits do not need to submit high school transcripts. Please mail all documents to:

Include your full name, address, and date of birth.

## 2. Accept

Priority Program Deadline: March 1

- ❑ **Confirmation Deposit** — When you pay your \$250 Confirmation Deposit, Liberty will mail you a free Liberty University USB, and you will be awarded a scholarship package based on the date you confirmed. For scholarship details call (800) 543-5317. This deposit is non-refundable unless requested in writing by December 1, 2009 for Spring 2010 applicants, and April 1, 2010, for Fall 2010 applicants.

- ❑ **Submit the FAFSA** (Online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)) — Be sure to use Liberty Code 010392
- ❑ **Apply for Federal Student Loans** — Students who indicate a loan interest on the FAFSA should apply using the information on the loans

## 3. A.S.I.S.T.

Priority Program Deadline: April 1

- ❑ **Financial Check-In** — Applicants may complete Financial Check-In (see website for details on when this will be available) by visiting [www.liberty.edu](http://www.liberty.edu), selecting the "Student Login/ASIST/Financial Check-In" button on our home page, and following the ASIST instructions.
